



DID YOU KNOW TURKEY'S ONE AND ONLY HAT MUSEUM WAS LOCATED IN KASTAMONU?

In order to immortalise and pass the name of the architect who built the government office of Kastamonu, Architect Vedat Tek, Culture and Art Centre was established and it is at service. It was opened in 31 October 2008 as a comprehensive centre illuminating the past with a different viewpoint. Inside this centre, the only example of Turkey; Hat and Lace Museum, and Cumhuriyet (Republic) House, Atatürk Convention Salon, Baby House and Picture Gallery are established.

The Hat Museum is the only example in Turkey as the Hat Revolution of Mustafa Kemal Atatürk took place in Kastamonu. The museum has men and women's hats from the first day of the Republic until today.
